Medical professionals, students, and nonmedical volunteers are all welcome!



What IMR does...

International Medical Relief offers short term medical mission trips for volunteer doctors, dentists, medical and non-medical professionals. We provide medical relief in areas where health care is limited or difficult to obtain and in disaster areas. Join us on a trip!

International Medical Relief promotes the well -being of underdeveloped communities through a comprehensive continuum of services provided on medical mission trips. On these 10 to 14 day medical mission trips, we provide diagnosis and treatment, establish partnerships with local medical relief designees, conduct community medical and wellness training, and foster principles of preventative health care. With our medical mission team, support staff, and the health care supplies and medicines we bring on each medical mission trip, we see hundreds of patients each clinic day.

International Medical Relief provides medical mission trips for general medical care, dental care, as well as several types of medical care specialties including plastic surgeons, general surgeons, oral surgeons, orthopedic surgeons and ophthalmic surgeons. Non-medical volunteers act as support staff and are an integral part of each team



Where we go...

IMR leads medical mission trips all over the world to Asia, Africa, South & Central America, and Eastern Europe.

What will I do...

Each medical clinic in and of itself is unique. There are variances in the medical skill set of each team, the patients that come to clinic, recent health outbreaks that may be affecting communities, and numerous other conditions that may be a factor. Keeping in mind that each experience is unique, IMR strives to bring continuity to our program and what we offer to our communities. Particular roles our volunteers try to fill include: patient intake and health history, triage, community health education, diagnosis and treatment, pharmacy, trip historian/photographer, interpreter, and more. Non-medical volunteers assist throughout every aspect of clinic and gain a true perspective of learning and working. Every job is as important as the other the clinics function well because of the variety of skills, coming together for this great cause.



What do I bring...

Once your application has been approved you will be given a comprehensive briefing packet that contains a packing list specific to the location you will be visiting and the time of year. IMR provides supplies for medical clinic; however medical volunteers are asked to bring their own diagnostics for use during clinic.

How much will it cost?

International Medical Relief trips are all inclusive. We take care of all of the logistics for your trip as well as the organization of the clinics in each area.

Disaster Relief



International Medical Relief provides medical mission trips to disaster relief areas to allow volunteers the opportunity to put their compassion into action to help survivors impacted by disasters around the world. Providing critical urgent needs in the immediate aftermath of a disaster is critical to ease the suffering caused in these situations. IMR supports a philosophy of First In – Last Out – Our goal is to get a team on the ground within the first week of a disaster.
