Guidelines and Information

- Poster abstract of 300 words in length will be accepted.
- In addition to abstract, <u>contact information</u>, <u>three learning objectives</u>, <u>and a completed Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form</u> will be required with submission consideration.

Abstract Guidelines: Abstracts must contain the following information:

- Poster-Title
- Author(s)-Names and e-mail addresses
- Keywords-Identify the keywords applicable to the submission
- Brief content description:
- List citations for evidence used (must have at least 1); provide the purpose statement for the presentation; identify the gap area to be addressed (knowledge, skill, practice, or other); provide a description of the current gap; and provide a description of the desired/achievable state.
- Presenters are responsible for their own travel and related expenses.
- Abstract submission deadline is May 6th.
- Notification of abstract acceptance will be June 1st or sooner.
- Confirmation of acceptance by primary author is required by July 1st or sooner.
