### RN/LPN REFRESHER

Refresher courses are offered once a year starting in mid-March.

The RN and LPN Refresher is intended for nurses who have been out of nursing practice for five years or longer and hold an active or limited nursing license in the state of Wisconsin. It includes theory and skills courses along with a clinical course that are to be completed within the same semester. The student is required to successfully complete the theory and skills courses prior to taking the clinical course.
