

NDNPA Leadership and Advocacy Award

The North Dakota Nurse Practitioner Association (NDNPA) Leadership and Advocacy Award recognizes a nurse practitioner who has demonstrated exceptional leadership in advancing the nurse practitioner role through legislative involvement, policy development, organizational leadership, or community advocacy. This award highlights NPs who strengthen the profession and improve access to quality healthcare across North Dakota.

The NDNPA Board Members-at-Large will distribute nomination materials to an independent outside selection committee. The award recipient will be notified upon selection and honored at the Annual Pharmacology Conference.

Award Eligibility Criteria:

- Current licensed nurse practitioner in North Dakota
- Active resident of North Dakota
- Demonstrated leadership in legislative, regulatory, or healthcare policy initiatives
- Evidence of involvement in professional organizations (local, state, or national)
- Submission of a 1–2 page narrative detailing leadership activities and measurable impact (self-nominations accepted)
- Nominee's CV or resume
