

NDNPA Rural Health Impact Award

The North Dakota Nurse Practitioner Association (NDNPA) Rural Health Impact Award recognizes a North Dakota nurse practitioner who has made significant contributions to improving access, quality, and outcomes of healthcare in rural or underserved communities across the state. This award honors an NP whose dedication reflects NDNPA's mission of promoting quality healthcare in North Dakota through support, advocacy, leadership, and continued education.

The NDNPA Board Members-at-Large are responsible for distributing nomination materials to an independent outside selection committee. The award recipient will be notified upon selection and honored at the Annual Pharmacology Conference.

Award Eligibility Criteria:

- Current licensed nurse practitioner in North Dakota
- Current resident of North Dakota and actively practicing in the state
- Practicing in a rural and/or underserved community within North Dakota
- Minimum of two (2) years of practice serving a rural or underserved population
- Demonstrated commitment to improving healthcare access, patient outcomes, or addressing healthcare disparities
- Active participation in continuing education or professional development
- Submission of a 1–2 page narrative describing the nominee's impact on rural or underserved healthcare in North Dakota (self-nominations accepted)
- Nominee's CV or resume
