Advising Notes: Other Prereqs for concentrations:

***ACCT 275, BUSI 290, BUSI 291** – When selecting one of these courses for your Concentration, please note these classes are a culmination of all of the prerequisite Business courses required and should be preferably taken in a student’s last semester at HACC. See course sequence below. Students in each concentration will need to take either an Internship or a Capstone course and advisors should encourage students desiring an internship to begin the search process at least one semester in advance.

ACCT 151 –Prerequisite: ACCT 150 (register first 7 weeks) and Acct 151 (second 7 weeks if needed)

ACCT 161 –Prerequisite: ACCT 160 with a C or higher AND ACCT 151 as a Co-req (or prereq).

ACCT 201 –Prerequisite: ACCT 151 or ACCT 200 with a C or higher

ACCT 203 – Prerequisite: ACCT 151 or ACCT 200 with a C or higher

ACCT 204 - Prerequisite: ACCT 161 or ACCT 200 with a C or higher

ACCT 215 – Prerequisite: ACCT 160 or ACCT 200 with a C or higher AND CIS 105 with a C or higher

ACCT 275 – Prerequisite: ACCT 201 with a C or higher; Coreq: ACCT 203,204, 215

BUSI 290 – Prerequisite: ACCT 160 OR ACCT 101, and BUSI 101, BUSI 201 or 209, CIS 105, ENGL 106, MGMT 201, MKTG 201 all with a C or higher. This course will be begin as an online offering only. In-class options will be added in the future.

BUSI 291 – Prerequisite: ACCT 160 OR ACCT 101, and BUSI 101, BUSI 201 or 209, CIS 105, ENGL 106, MGMT 201, MKTG 201 all with a C or higher. This course will be begin as an online offering only. In-class options will be added in the future.
