COMM 101	3 cr	Effective Speaking	Pre-req: eligibility for enrollment into ENGL 101 and completion of any reading courses as required by the College Testing and Placement Program

- A grade of C or higher is required for BIOL 111 or 121; COMM 101; and all DA courses.
- Graduates of the Dental Assisting program can enroll in Expanded Function Dental Auxiliary (EFDA, 320A) by applying to the program and, upon acceptance, completing DA 252 Expanded Functions I (4 cr, Semester 1) and DA 253 Expanded Functions II (2 cr, Semester 2).
