COMM 101	3 cr	Effective Speaking	Pre-req: eligibility for enrollment into ENGL 101 and completion of any reading courses as required by the College Testing and Placement Program
PSYCH 101	3 cr	General Psychology	Pre-req: completion of ENGL 003, 007, or 057 with a grade of C or higher
BIOL 121	4 cr	Anatomy & Physiology I	Pre-req: completion of developmental reading and writing; High school academic biology and chemistry or HACC equivalent (BIOL 108/111/115; CHEM 100)
BIOL 221	4 cr	Microbiology	Pre-req: high school academic biology and chemistry or HACC equivalent (BIOL 108/111/115; *CHEM 100)

Advising Notes

- MATH 022 is required to meet admission criteria (to apply to clinicals) for the LPN program.
- ***CHEM 100** is required ONLY IF it is needed to meet pre-requisite for BIOL 221.
- ***MATH 033, 044, 055** are pre-requisites to CHEM 100.
- C grade or better in ALL coursework (developmental, general education and clinical coursework).
