

## Program Description

The Artists-in-Residence (AIR) Program at HACC, Central Pennsylvania's Community College, is a unique residency opportunity open to emerging artists who have completed their undergraduate degree in ceramics and are seeking opportunities that will allow them to further their experience and concentrate on their art practice for a period of up to two years. During the residency, the AIR will have complete access to various studios and equipment as well as the college library. They will also participate in and assist the studio classes in their respective area and will have the opportunity to meet with faculty for critiques and discussions. The residency will culminate in a solo exhibition at one of HACC's art galleries.

In the ceramics studio area, the AIR is expected to assist the professor who oversees that area with studio maintenance and general skilled support in classes as arranged with the individual faculty member. The AIR will provide eight hours per week of studio assistance.

This program is funded by a grant from the Freas Foundation and will provide a stipend to the artist in residence of \$4,480 per year, with an additional \$1,460 for supplies.

*For full consideration for the Fall 2015 semester, applications must be submitted by April 15, 2015.*

- Send letter of intent. (It should outline the reason you're applying, what you will bring to the program and your goals for the residency.)
- Resume
- 15-20 images of recent work
- Transcript(s) of any colleges attended
- Two professional letters of reference
