ADP Admission requirements are as follows: 1) applicants must be 21 years of age or older; 2) must have 3 years of work, volunteer experience, or have family obligations; 3) strong preference for an associate degree, but a minimum of 48 transferable college credits (including English 101) is acceptable; 4) must have basic computer technology proficiency; 5) must complete application and send official transcripts. **Please note:** Career and transfer degrees are accepted and students who have either will be awarded a scholarship.

Any AA degree at HACC (61 credits)

Students in **most majors*** should be able to transfer up to 78 credits into **any** Albright College's Accelerated Degree Program Bachelor's program. It would be helpful (but not necessary for admittance) for students transferring to Albright to have met the General Education requirements below. All other courses eligible for transfer in a HACC Associate's degree will be applied to Albright's Bachelor's programs as electives. The bold notations in parenthesis below are Albright College's General Education requirements."

*Examples of majors that would not transfer the majority of credits: Heating, Ventilation, & Air Conditioning, Building Construction Management and Automotive Technology Associate degrees. Please contact Albright College if you have questions surrounding the transfer of any HACC program.

Typical HACC General Education Requirements in any HACC AA that will transfer to Albright Accelerated:

- _____ ENGL 101 (**English Composition I**) transfers as ENG 101 English Composition I(ENGL - 1)
- _____ ENGL 102 (**English Composition II**)transfers as ENG 102 Writing with Texts (ENGL - 2)
- _____ Core A (**Foundations-Humanities**) Suggested: ENGL 201, ENGL 202, ENGL 207, ENGL 207H, HUM 201(D), HUM 202(D), HUM 202(H). As of fall 2017, all other Core A courses would transfer, these are just suggested for optimal transfer.
- _____ Core B (**Foundations-Social Sciences**) Suggested: ANTH 101(D), ANTH 201, ECON 201, ECON 202, GP 201, GP 202, PSYC 101, PSYC 213, PSYC 221, PSYC 229(D), SOCI 201(D), SOCI 201H(D), SOCI 202(D), SOCI 203(D), SOCI 205 (D). As of fall 2017, all other Core B courses would transfer, these are just suggested for optimal transfer.
- _____ Core C Science (**Foundations-Natural Science**) Suggested: ASTR 103, ASTR 104, BIOL 101, BIOL 103, BIOL 103H, BIOL 108, BIOL 121, BIOL 122, BIOL 221, CHEM 101, CHEM 102, CHEM 113, CHEM 203, METR 101, PHYS 201, PHYS 202, PHYS 211. As of fall 2017, all other courses under 'Core C' would transfer as elective credit or fulfill other areas.
- _____ Diversity Core (**Foreign Language/Culture I**) Suggested: COMM 253, COMM 253H, CHIN 101, CJ 240, ENGL 269, FRCH 101, FRCH 102, FRCH 201, FRCH 202, GEOG 230, GRMN 101, GRMN 102, HUM 101, HUM 101H, HUM 201, HUM 201(H), MUSI 104, PHIL 200, PSYC 229, SOCI 205, SPAN101, SPAN 102, SPAN 201, SPAN 202.
As of Fall 2017, the following courses will not transfer: AOS 225 and any CULI courses.
- _____ Physical Education/Wellness Core (**Elective**) Suggested: NURS 150. Albright College will only accept PE courses for transfer for HACC AA/AS degree holders under Core-to-Core agreement
- _____ Electives Suggested: Students have a wide variety of courses that will transfer as elective credits. Please consult with Albright College Enrollment Advisor for more information. As of fall 2017, the only area of approved electives to avoid would be the PE courses, although they would transfer under Core-to-Core agreement.
- _____ First Year Seminar- these courses do not transfer.
