- 0-level courses do **not** count toward graduation credits and they do **not** transfer.
- Suggested minimum GPA for Early Childhood Education Majors is 3.0.**
- Admission to MU's Early Childhood Education Advanced Professional Studies is not granted automatically. Students must successfully complete the PAPA Test and other curriculum requirements before they can be admitted to the Education Advanced Professional Studies block at MU. **Students are strongly encouraged to complete the PAPA I prior to completion of 60 credits.** It is suggested that you take these tests during the semester prior to transfer to MU. Students must also have satisfactory Act 34 (Criminal Record Check), Act 114 (FBI Fingerprint), and Act 151(Child Abuse) reports.
- Courses for Millersville University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and MU. However, curricula are subject to change and it is in your best interest to speak with your advisor and/or the MU transfer advisor if you have any questions.
- Admissions is competitive so apply early: Fall application recommended deadline - Feb 1 (must include transcript)
