1. Developmental courses (courses that begin with a 0) do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer.
2. Minimum admission GPA requirement for Education students is [3.0](#).
3. **Recommended Application Deadlines:** Students are advised to apply before March for Fall enrollment at MU and before October for spring enrollment at MU.
4. **MU requires 3 courses that transfer as their 200 level or above:** For Education majors these are satisfied with:
- ENGL 201, 202, 203, 204 or 207, PSYC 212 or EDUC 185, ANTH 101, HIST 101,107.214, SOC 202, 203, 205

5. **To enroll in the Dual Admissions Program, the following criteria must be met:**
 - HACC student currently enrolled in an AA, AS or AAS degree transfer program
 - Minimum 3.0 GPA
 - Submission of a Dual Admission Program application (available at a HACC Welcome Center) application soon to be online
 - Continuous enrollment (excluding summer)
 - At the time of the application has completed under 30 college level credits
 - Completion of AA, AS or AAS degree at HACC prior to enrollment at MU

6. Courses for Millersville University have been selected by joint agreement from HACC and MU. Curricula are subject to change. This guide should be used with the assistance of a HACC Education Counselor/Advisor and or MU representative.
