

Transfer Institution: **Millersville University****Criminal Justice (#6050) at HACC (Prior to Fall 2018)**

This check sheet meets the requirements for the AA Degree in Criminal Justice from HACC and admission with Junior status in the **Sociology: Criminology Option** at Millersville University. You **MUST** follow the **General Transfer Option** of the HACC Criminal Justice Curriculum and follow the recommended courses if you wish to transfer with no loss of credits. The requirements for MU are the bold, underlined notations within the parenthesis i.e. (**Foundations - 1**).

Course numbers that are underlined on the right hand column meet upper level requirements at MU. Courses that are in bold meet “writing” (W) requirements at MU. It is important to take these courses as part of your major at HACC. MATH 202 MUST be completed with a C- or higher and SOCI 201 MUST be completed with a C or higher to enter MU as a Sociology major. HACC Diversity requirement (3 cr) is fulfilled by courses designated with (D). They are not equivalent to MU Diversity courses.
