- 1) Courses for Millersville University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and MU based on current academic year. Curricula are subject to change. It is the students' responsibility to speak with their advisor for any changes or updates.
- 2) 0-level courses do **not** count toward graduation credits and they do **not** transfer.
- 3) **Technology and Engineering Education majors are encouraged to take ENGL 201-207 (select one), PSYC 101 and PSYC 212. Minimum preferred GPA for Educ. Majors: 3.0.**
- 4) Admissions is competitive so apply early: Fall application deadline - Feb 1 (must include transcript)  
Spring application deadline - September 1 (must include transcript)
- 5) Admission to MU's Education Advanced Professional Studies is not granted automatically. Students must successfully complete the PAPA Test and meet other curriculum requirements before they can be admitted to the Education Advanced Professional Studies block at MU. **It is suggested that you take these tests prior to 45 credits.** Students must also have satisfactory Act 34 (Criminal Record Check), Act 114 (FBI Fingerprint), and Act 151(Child Abuse) reports.
