Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

-Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar waived for students who have at least 30 transferable credits)

- Writing^W, Oral Communication^O, History^H, Quantitative^Q

-Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives

- Diversity^D, Global Perspectives^G, Foreign Language^F

-Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category

- Citizenship^S, Ethical Reasoning^E, Critical Reasoning^R

-Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category

- Natural World^N, Technology^T

-Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category

- Literature^L, Arts^A, Creative^C

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SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

1. English Literary and Professional/Creating Writing concentration majors are allowed 33 credits in free electives. These electives could be fulfilled with courses in a Minor program and/or courses in the English Major. Elective credits for English with Secondary Education majors will not count toward graduation requirements.
2. B.A. students must satisfy a foreign language requirement. This is accomplished via 3 years of the same language in high school, an AP score of at least 2, or the completion of a 103 level course. Three credits of a foreign language may count under the foreign language general education requirement.
3. PSYC 101 (PSY 101 at SHIP) is required of English with Secondary Education majors. PSYC 101 is not required of Literary or Writing concentration majors.
4. English majors at SHIP must choose from the following sequence of Required Survey Courses: (American Lit I or Brit Lit I) **and** (American Lit II or Brit Lit II). In contrast, HACC requires one Brit Lit course and one American Lit course. Therefore, students should choose HACC's ENGL 201 and 204 **or** 202 and 203. Please speak with your advisor for further clarification.
5. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HACC for transfer to SU. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor for advisement on additional coursework.
6. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer. FS courses may not transfer.
7. Courses for SU have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor from SU visits the Wildwood campus on a bi-weekly basis through the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions for the specific day and time.
8. In order to transfer into the English program at SU, students must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA or a 3.0 GPA for English Secondary Education.
9. **FOR ENGLISH EDUCATION MAJORS ONLY**
 - 9.1. Because some SU English Secondary Education courses run only in the Fall or Spring semester, transfer students **must** take EDU 290 during their first Fall semester at SU in order to student teach during the Spring semester of the following year.
 - 9.2. Students seeking certification in secondary education must complete 2 math courses. It is recommended (but not required) that students complete both math courses prior to transferring to SU. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor for advisement on additional coursework.
 - 9.3. Please see the Required Forms and Clearances for Education Majors Document on Shippensburg University's website at http://www.ship.edu/COEHS/Field_Services/Clearance_Information/
 - 9.4. Applicants with more than 48 credits are strongly encouraged to meet the PA Basic Academic Skills Requirement prior to transferring to Shippensburg. Options include meeting the required minimum scores on the PAPA series, CORE series, SAT, or ACT. Failure to do so could result in not being able to take education courses until the requirement is met.
