### Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

- -Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not currently required for transfer students)
  - Writing<sup>W</sup>, Oral Communication<sup>O</sup>, History<sup>H</sup>, Quantitative<sup>Q</sup>
- -Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives
  - Diversity<sup>D</sup>, Global Perspectives<sup>G</sup>, Foreign Langauge<sup>F</sup>
- -Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category
  - Citizenship<sup>S</sup>, Ethical Reasoning<sup>E</sup>, Critical Reasoning<sup>R</sup>
- -Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category
  - Natural World<sup>N</sup>, Technology<sup>T</sup>
- -Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category
  - Literature<sup>L</sup>, Arts<sup>A</sup>, Creative<sup>C</sup>

### NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

- 1. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HACC for transfer to Shippensburg. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer advisor for advisement on additional coursework.
- 2. The program allows for 20 free elective credits. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer. HD courses may not transfer.
- 3. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. This guide should be used with the assistance of a HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following the guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission into Shippensburg University. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer advisor if you have any questions. A transfer advisor from Shippensburg University visits the Wildwood campus on a biweekly basis throughout the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions or check the SU website at www.ship.edu for the specific day and time.
- 4. The BSW program at SHIP requires the following GPA for admission into the program: 0-29 credits 2.2 GPA, 30-59 credits 2.4 GPA, 60 or more credits 2.5 GPA.
- 5. Students may use PSYC 241 in place of MATH 202 for this major; however, another math will have to be completed to meet graduation requirements for both HACC and Shippensburg. Please note that pre-requisites for PSYC 241 are completion of PSYC 101 with a grade of "C" or better and eligibility for enrollment in MATH 103.
- 6. Recommended Application Deadlines: Students are advised to apply one semester prior to the desired transfer date.
- 7. Evening cohort BSW degree will be offered in Harrisburg, Fall 2020 (Tentative). The following are the required pre-requisites for admission into the program:
  - At least 48 transferable credits (60 credits preferred) with a minimum 2.4 GPA from all work previously completed at accredited institutions
  - The following courses must be successfully passed prior to starting the cohort:
    - O SWK 102 Social Work in Social Welfare (HUMS 120) passed with a C or higher
    - o SWK 250 Assessing Individuals in the Social Environment (HUMS 206 or PSYC 209)
    - o SOC 265 Understanding Diversity for Social Work Practice (SOCI 205)
    - College Math Placement Level 2 (Placement required to take Statistics)
