-Part 2: Categories of Knowledge

- ^ACategory A Logic & Numbers for Rational Thinking (1 course – 3 credits)
- ^BCategory B Linguistic, Literary, Artistic, & Cultural Traditions (3 courses – 9 credits)
- ^CCategory C Biological & Physical Sciences (3 courses – 9 credits)
- ^DCategory D Political, Economic, and Geographic Sciences (2 courses – 6 credits)
- ^ECategory E Social and Behavioral Sciences (2 courses – 6 credits)

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SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

1. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HACC for transfer to Shippensburg. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor for advisement on additional coursework.
2. The major allows for 30 free elective credits. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer. FS courses may not transfer.
3. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor from SU visits the Wildwood campus on a bi-weekly basis through the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions for the specific day and time.
4. Psychology at SHIP requires a 2.3 cumulative GPA in order to gain admission.
5. B.A. students must satisfy the Novice level competency in a foreign language. This is accomplished via 3 years of the same language in high school, an AP score of at least 2, or the completion of a 103 level course. Three credits of a foreign language may count under category B general education requirement.
6. Students who take PSYC 241 and PSYC 242 at HACC will receive transfer credit for PSY 205 and PSY 301 at SHIP (the requirement for PSY 105 will be waived). If students only take PSYC 241 at HACC they will only receive credit for PSY 105 at Ship.
