1. **Recommended** time to apply: March 1 for a fall semester; end of September 1 for a spring semester
2. **Deadline** for applications: Rolling admissions; no deadline; close when all spaces have been filled. Best to apply by above dates to participate in early registration.
3. **Application Fee:** Online app \$40; paper app \$50; waived for Dual Admit Students.
4. Will you evaluate a **transcript** prior to formal application? Unofficially only, except for Dual admit students
5. Number of **transfer students admitted:** Fall: 600 Spring: 200 Summer: We do not admit for summer but all students admitted for fall can enroll in summer classes.
6. **On-Campus Housing?** Yes for **single parents?** No **Off-Campus Housing?** Yes
7. Does your college/university have any support services targeted for **students of color?** Scholarships and a summer program available for incoming freshmen; tutoring, study skills workshops and a mentoring program are available to all students.

1. What is the minimum number of credits required for transfer? 12
2. What is the maximum number of credits accepted from a 2-year college? Unlimited but MU requires at least 30 credits including 50% of major requirements (excluding student teaching) be completed at MU for MU to award a degree.
3. What is the minimum GPA (on 4.0 scale) for acceptance? 2.0 for fulltime admission; part time programs available for those with weaker academic records.
4. What curricula have required **GPA's**? (Please list curriculum and required GPA.) None
5. Are any programs closed to transfer students? No
6. Students transferring from HACC may have taken developmental (0 level) courses, which are included in their GPA's. Does your institution recalculate HACC GPA's to exclude developmental courses? No

Minimum of 3.6 GPA but also depends on strength of applicant pool.
