The Consecrated Christian's New View of His Enemies (pt 2)

Vengence Is His

Romans 12:14,17-21

The Context of Romans 12

- 1. A call to consecrate ourselves unto God. Rom 12:1.2
- 2. Application: How we are to view ourselves. Rom 12:3-8.
- 3. Application: How we are to love others. Rom 12:9-16
- 4. Application: How we are to love our enemies. Rom 12:14,17-21.

In Words: Bless Those Who Curse You. Rom 12:14

- 1. The Negative Command: Do not curse those who curse you
 - It's the natural response of the victim to strike back...it is to be *mean*
 - ♦ You must not strike back in words. Prov 17:14; 15:1
 - ♦ Christ did not strike back in words. I Pet 2:21-23
- 2. The Positive Command: Bless (ευλογεω eulogeo) those who curse you. Eulogize them
 - ♦ Bless them to their face -- as Christ did. I Pet 2:21-22.
 - ♦ Bless them behind their back -- your words dictate the course of your heart. James 2
 - ♦ Bless them before God in prayer -- as Moses humbly did for his enemies. Numbers 12

In Deeds: Do Good To Those Who Hurt You. Rom 12:17-18

- 1. The Negative Command: Never pay back evil for evil
 - God does not call us to react to evil men -- instead we are to respond to Him. Lk 17:3f.
 - ♦ The focus here is not civil justice or self-defense. The issue is revenge. Gen 34.
- 2. The Positive Command: Respect what is right in the sight of all men.
 - ♦ The stakes: Your witness for Christ. Phil 4:5,
 - ♦ E.G. Christ & the Roman Centurion -- saved by seeing Christ's response.

In Justice: Do Good & Leave Room For God's Justice. Rom 12:19-20

- 1. The Negative Command: Do not take revenge -- leave room for God's wrath.
 - ♦ It is God's privilege alone. Ps 2; 76:10; Isa 63:3; Rev 14:19-20; 19:13-15
 - Wrath becomes God -- wrath does not become us.
 - The reason we do not take vengeance is that the sin ultimately is against God.
 - It is therefore His prerogative to judge
- 2. The Positive Command: Feed enemy, give drink. Do him good.
 - ♦ We are to mirror God's kindness
 - Our life here on earth images the life of the Son -- So does our eternity.

The Reason: Either Good Or Evil Is The Victor In This Matter. Rom 12:21

- 1. The Negative: Don't be overcome by evil
 - Vengeance & self-righteousness go hand-in-hand
 - ♦ Vengeance is Satanic. Eph 4:26,27
 - ♦ No vengeful person is happy -- bitterness, anger, destroys you!
- 2. The Positive: Overcome evil with good

- 1. Are you a new creature in Christ? It's the only possible way to become a forgiver.
- 2. You must really believe in God rule! Cf. Isa 14:12-12; Dan 4:28f
- 3. You must really believe in & love the Gospel! Mt 18:21-35; 6:12.
