Proof of Identity

Effective January 1, 2010, Florida law requires all applicants for a driver license or identification card to present the following identification documents:



• An original birth certificate, valid U.S. Passport, U.S. Passport Card, original Certificate of Naturalization, or Report of Birth Abroad (no copies or hospital certificates will be accepted);

AND

• Original name change documents for all (marriage, divorce, adoption, legal name change, etc.) must be presented at the time of application (may require more than one and must show a continuous link from birth name to current legal name); church marriage documents are not acceptable:

AND



Two proofs of Florida residential address from two different sources, which show the same address (current utility bill, lease, car payment book, see complete list on reverse). Mail from the Florida Division of Driver License not acceptable for proof of address;

AND



An original Social Security card or acceptable proof of Social Security number (see complete list and acceptance requirements on reverse).

Social Security cards and records must match name being used before issuance of a Florida driver license or identification card. Contact the Social Security Administration at least 24 hrs before making application for a driver license or identification card when changing names using a corrected W-2 or 1099 as proof of Social Security number.

NOTE: Applicants under age 18 must have signed parental consent. Must present and surrender all Florida and out-of-state driver licenses and ID cards.

 Original/renewal CDL license fee: \$81.25
- Replacement license fee: \$31.25
- Identification card fee: \$31.25

Proof of Residential Address Includes Two of the Following:

NOTE: all proof of residential address documents must have identical addresses.

- 1. Deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet, or residential rental/lease agreement
- 2. Florida voter registration card with address
- 3. Florida vehicle registration or title
- 4. Florida vessel registration or title (if living on a vessel / houseboat)
- 5. Statements:
 - Customers under 18 a statement from a parent, stepparent, or legal guardian of the minor is required. The parent, guardian, or stepparent must reside at the same residential address as the minor. The parent, guardian, or stepparent who accompanies the minor will give a verbal statement that the minor resides at the same address and present two proofs of residential address. The parent, guardian, or stepparent who cannot accompany the minor must complete a statement through a Certification of Address (Form HSMV-71120) with two proofs of residential address.
 - Customers 18 years or older customers who reside with someone must provide a statement through a Certification of Address (Form HSMV-71120) from that person, along with two proofs of residential address in that person's name.
- 6. A utility bill, hook-up, or work order dated within 60 days of the application
- 7. Automobile payment booklet
- 8. Selective Service card
- 9. Medical or health card with address listed
- 10. Current homeowner's insurance policy or bill
- 11. Current automobile insurance policy or bill
- 12. Educational institution transcript forms for the current school year
- 13. Un-expired professional license issued by a government agency in the U.S. or local business tax receipt
- 14. W-2 form or 1099 form (hand written not acceptable)
- 15. Form DS2019, Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J-1) status
- 16. Homeless: letter from a homeless shelter, transitional service provider, or halfway house verifying that customer resides at the shelter address; sexual offender/predator/career offender: FDLE registration form completed by local sheriff's office
- 17. Property tax bill or record
- 18. Mail from financial institutions, including checking, savings, or investment account statements, not more than two months old (*limit one per institution*)
- 19. Mail from Federal, State, County, or City government agencies, with the exception of mail from the Florida Division of Driver License.

Proof of Social Security Number

Social Security number is collected pursuant to Chapter 322, Florida Statutes.

Acceptable Documents Are:

- Social Security card
- Non-SSA Form 1099

• W-2 form

Paycheck stub showing name and number

• SSA Form 1099

Note: The document must include the customer's full Social Security number to be accepted; handwritten documents are not accepted.
