IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION

Parking: Buses and Pit trucks will enter through the Amwell Road lot only. (see map). Volunteers and Spectators will enter and park in the Homestead Road lot.

Restrooms: Restrooms for warm up area for band are located in the front entrance of the gym. There will also be restrooms open in the stadium area behind the food booth.

Member Re-Entry: Band members in uniform will be allowed entry/re-entry. Hand Stamps will be used to identify performing students to be allowed back in stadium if out of uniform. PIT parents will receive wristbands upon arrival to be used for re-entry.

Tickets: Tickets are \$10.00 for adults and \$8.00 for students and seniors. Ages 5 and under are free. Tickets and Programs can be purchased at the ticket booth adjacent to the entrance gate to the stadium.

Warm Up: Bands will warm up near soccer fields on the Amwell Road side. Marching Band pit will warm up in the Amwell Road parking lot. Hillsborough Band Hosts will direct you.

Field Surface: Field is artificial turf with standard high school football field hash marks.

Power on field: There will be a power extension cord located by the 50 yard line.

Competition Suite: Adjudicator commentary for all USBands ensembles can be located in Competition Suite shortly after the conclusion of each ensemble's performance. Directors may grant access to the ensemble's portal with staff/instructors, and may request help from USBands representatives to resolve any issues accessing Competition Suite.

Retreat/Critique: Drum Majors and Colorguard Captains only will report on the track by the end zone nearest the flag pole.upon the completion of Hillsborough's Exhibition performance. Following awards, Critique will be held in the Indoor Teachers Louge off of the HS Commons. Access the High School through the Media Center doors facing the Stadium. Proceed straight – Teacher's Lounge/Critique Room to the left.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third place, as well as caption awards.

Concessions: All Concessions and food vendors are located in the stadium area to the right of the performance field.

Credentials/Access: Any USBands staff member, band member with handstamp, PIT parent with wristband, or paid admissions with wristband can enter the stadium. Only those with USBands Staff credentials are allowed access to the Hospitality Room/Critique Room.

Exit to Route 202/206 South – "Somerville, Princeton"

Travel ¼ mile to the Somerville traffic circle, the follow signs for Route 206 South – "Princeton"

(See directions "From Somerville Circle" below)

Via Interstate 287 Northbound:

Exit at exit # 14 to Route 22 West – "Somerville" (LEFT LANE EXIT!)
Exit to Route 202/206 South – "Somerville, Princeton" (approx. 3 miles)
Travel ¼ mile to the Somerville traffic circle, the follow signs for Route 206 South – "Princeton"
(See directions "From Somerville Circle" below)

Via Interstate 287 Southbound:

Exit at exit # 17 to Route 202/206 South – "Somerville, Princeton"

Travel 1 mile to the Somerville traffic circle, the follow signs for Route 206 South – "Princeton"

(See directions "From Somerville Circle" below)

Via Interstate 78 East or West:

Exit at exit # 29 to Interstate 287 South – "Somerville"

Exit at exit # 17 to Route 202/206 South – "Somerville, Princeton" (approx. 3 miles)

Travel 1 mile to the Somerville traffic circle, the follow signs for Route 206 South – "Princeton"

FROM SOMERVILLE CIRCLE:


Travel halfway around the Somerville circle – take the 3rd exit for Route 206 South – "Princeton"

Travel approx. 6 miles to Amwell Road (Route 514) – Turn right onto Amwell Road (Amwell Road is second traffic light after McDonalds)
High School is on left (¾ mile)

FROM THE SOUTH (PRINCETON AREA):

Travel North on Route 206 from Princeton through Montgomery and Belle Mead into Hillsborough Township. (approx. 8 miles)

After passing an intersection with a Valero and Kwik-Fill gas stations, continue traveling North to the second traffic light (Raider Blvd.) Turn left at Raider Blvd. High School is ¼ mile on left.





SITE OVERVIEW MAP






ENSEMBLE PARKING & WARMUP

SEVERE WEATHER PLAN

Arrival: Bands, (including pit and guard) will enter through the doors on the Amwell Road side of the school. There are several doors and staff parent will assist you.

Parking: Spectator parking will remain in the same location (on the football stadium side of the school). Spectators will enter the school through the cul-desac entrance, by the Media Center. They will be directed past the Commons and down the hall on the left to the main gym.

Bus/pit parking will remain in the Amwell Road lot. No cars, trucks or buses will be allowed to park in the cul-de-sac, which must be kept clear at all times.

Restrooms: Restrooms for spectators will be just outside the main gym entrance. Bands can use restrooms located in the hall directly outside the Commons.

Member Re-entry: Band members in uniform will be allowed entry/re-entry. Hand Stamps will be used to identify performing students to be allowed back into the school if out of uniform. PIT parents will receive wristbands upon arrival to be used for re-entry.

Warm-up: Pit and battery will be located in hallways, guards will be in sections in the Commons and bands will warm up in auxiliary gym/chorus room. Band, pit and guard will then all be staged behind the red curtain to enter the main gym for performance.

Performance Area: Main Gymnasium

Power: Power will be located in the center of the gym floor (50 yard line).

Retreat/Critique: Judge Host will guide you to Critique Room located adjacent to Commons.

Tickets: Tickets are \$10.00 for adults and \$8.00 for students and seniors. Tickets and programs will be sold at the entrance near the Media Center

Souvenirs/Merchandise: Souvenirs/merchandise will be available in the outskirts of the Commons area along the hallway.

Concessions: In the Commons.
