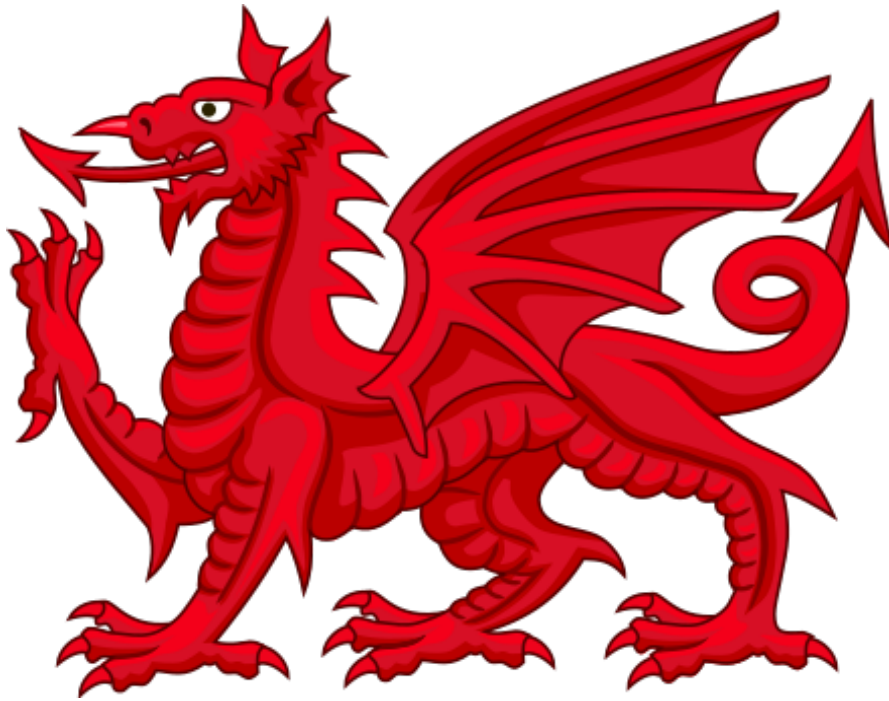

IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION

Parking: Parking is extremely limited at Bangor Park. Bands will be asked to have buses drop off their members and then proceed to Washington Elementary School (381 Washington Boulevard Bangor, PA 18013) or Washington Township Fire Company (920 Washington Boulevard Bangor, PA 18103) to park. One bus from each band may return and park in the designated bus parking area so drivers may attend the festival. Sorry for the inconvenience. Spectators will be asked to utilize street parking around Bangor Park. No charge for parking. Equipment trucks will remain at Bangor Park.

Restrooms: There are two restrooms inside the Bangor Park Stadium. Members and spectators may utilize either restroom throughout the evening.

Member Re-Entry: Returning band members should enter the stadium via the band entrance gate in the rear of the stadium. There will not be hand stamps or wrist bands.

Tickets: Tickets will be available at the entrance gate for \$10.00.

Warm Up: Student guides will accompany every band throughout the evening. Designated warm up areas will be on the baseball field, on sand volleyball courts, and in grassy areas behind the stadium. All of these areas are within close proximity of the field, so please be courteous to performing ensembles and face away from the stadium.

Field Surface: The field at Bangor Park Stadium is natural grass. The field will be lined with High School hash marks and all standard field markings. There is a short incline into the stadium at the entrance gate.

Power on field: Power will be provided at the 50 yard line on the front sideline.

Competition Suite: Adjudicator commentary for all USBands ensembles can be located in Competition Suite shortly after the conclusion of each ensemble's performance. Directors may grant access to the ensemble's portal with staff/instructors, and may request help from USBands representatives to resolve any issues accessing Competition Suite.

Retreat/Critique: Drum Majors and Colorguard Captains should report to the back sideline during the exhibition performance by the ESU Marching Band. Critique will take place in the Hospitality Tent next to the home bleachers.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded to every band. Certificates will be awarded for Caption Awards.

Souvenirs/Merchandise: Souvenirs/Merchandise will be available near the concession stand.

Concessions: There are two concession stands at Bangor Park Stadium. One is near the spectators' bleachers, and the other is near the band members' bleachers. There will be baked goods, candy grams, and air grams available for purchase in addition to the concessions.

Credentials/Access: Those with USBands credentials will have access to all areas of the stadium including the Hospitality Tent/Critique. Bus Drivers will also have access to the Hospitality Tent.
