


Electricity distribution in France

- The public electricity distribution grid belongs to the communities which entrust their maintenance and development to Enedis
- Enedis is the main manager of the French distribution grid covering 95% of the country
- Its activity is monitored by the Energy Regulation Commission (known as CRE)




