

What does this policy cover?

This policy describes how SEE and 3AF organizing associations of ETTC will make use of your data to purchase membership or information from our websites (www.see.asso.fr and www.3af.fr).

It also describes your data protection rights, including a right to object to some of the processing which SEE and 3AF carry out. More information about your rights, and how to exercise them, is set out in the “What rights do I have?” section.

What information do we collect?

We collect and process personal data about you when you interact with us and our websites, and when you purchase services from us. This includes:

- your name
- your email address
- your phone number
- your address
- information related to the browser or device you use to access our website

Recording

The organizers may utilize its own preferences to limit participant activity such as recording the conference. The organizers may likewise record the audio and/or video of the conference on its own. By registering to ETTC’21, the participant authorizes the organizers to broadcast its image and the recording of its presentation during the virtual conference of June 15 and 16, 2021 and during the replays on the ETTC website.

Any data recorded shall be exclusively kept secure in the organizers’ storage drive or the organizers’ cloud storage account.

Consent

By registering to ETTC’21, the participant gives its consent and submits its compliance to the use of a third party video conference service for the virtual conference participation scheduled on June 15-16, 2021.

The participant further gives its consent to the acquiring of my personal information by the virtual conference service provider and storage of my information to data centers located in France.

How do we use this information, and what is the legal basis for this use?

We process this personal data for the following purposes:

- To fulfil a contract, or take steps linked to a contract: this is relevant where you make a purchase from us. This includes: verifying your identity; communicating with you; providing information and sending newsletters
- Where we have a legitimate interest. This includes: to conduct research, analysis and analytics of our websites and newsletters traffic

- Where you give us consent: we will send you newsletters in relation to our relevant events and latest news, or other services provided by us. We place cookies and use similar technologies in accordance with our Cookies Policy and the information provided to you when those technologies are used on other occasions where we ask you for consent, we will use the data for the purpose which we explain at that time.

Withdrawing consent or otherwise objecting to newsletters

Wherever we rely on your consent, you will always be able to withdraw that consent, although we may have other legal grounds for processing your data for other purposes, such as those set out above. You have an absolute right to opt-out of newsletters, or profiling we carry out for newsletters, at any time. You can do this by following the instructions in the communication where this is an electronic message, or by contacting us using the details set out below.

What rights do I have?

You have the right to ask us to correct, delete or restrict (stop any active) processing of your personal data; and to obtain the personal data you provide to us for a contract or with your consent in a structured, machine readable format, and to ask us to share(port) this data to another controller.

In addition, you can object to the processing of your personal data in some circumstances (in particular, where we don't have to process the data to meet a contractual or other legal requirement, or where we are using the data for direct marketing).

These rights may be limited, for example if fulfilling your request would reveal personal data about another person, or if you ask us to delete information which we are required by law to keep or have compelling legitimate interests in keeping.

To exercise any of these rights, you can get in touch with us using the details set out below. If you have unresolved concerns, you have the right to complain to an EU data protection authority where you live, work or where you believe a breach may have occurred.

How do I get in touch with you?

How long will you retain my data?

Where we process registration data, we do this for as long as you are an active user of our sites and for 12 months after this.

Where we process personal data for newsletters purposes or with your consent, we process the data until you ask us to stop and for a short period after this (to allow us to implement your requests). We also keep a record of the fact that you have asked us not to send you newsletters or to process your data so that we can respect your request in future.

Language
