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Supply List:

- 11"x14" canvas or any suitable paintable surface
- Accessible printer for included printable PDF resources
- Pair of scissors for cutting out printable PDF resources
- Acrylic gel medium – or Modge Podge / Collage Podge (for collaging printable PDF cutouts onto your surface) {I used Golden brand Regular Gel (Matte)}
- Pencil
- Eraser
- ***Fluid*** acrylic paints:
 - Titanium white
 - Hansa yellow light (or bright sunshine yellow) {I used Golden brand}
 - Diarylide Yellow (or yellow orange) {I used Golden brand}
 - Quinacridone Magenta {I used Golden brand}
 - Anthroquinone Blue {I used Golden brand}
 - Paynes Gray {I used Golden brand}
 - Carbon black {I used Golden brand}
 - Red (any red will do, as you only use a drop for Peter's feathered hat) {I used Golden brand}
 - Green Gold (or light neutral green for Peter's shirt) {I used Golden brand}
 - Leaf Green (or dark neutral green for Peter's pants)
 - Baby Blue (any light blue for Wendy's dress – you can also make it yourself by mixing white + blue)
 - Brown paint (For Wendy's hair, Peter's shoes and belt) {I used Golden brand Quinacridone Nickle Azo Gold and Burnt Umber Light}
- Glitter (I recommend extra fine glitter but that's just my preference) {I used Martha Stewart brand Smoky Quartz and/or gold glitter}

Brushes:

- #1 Simply Simmons Script Brush (any tiny tipped brush will do)
- ½" or ¾" Filbert brush (any medium sized brush will do)
