

Using [www.Fiverr.com](https://www.fiverr.com)

- Jobs are called gigs
- Each gig is \$5. Fiverr.com adds an additional % (usually \$1-2)
- Search the job you want done and do your research before ordering

Examples:

Search voiceover:

Refine results (left menu bar)

- Male female
- Category (Radio)
- Delivery time
- Cost, budget, price range
- Rating - seller level
- Top seller and Level two usually better, but I have found good new sellers too.
- Level is based on time on fiverr.com and how many 5 star reviews

Researching a Seller:

- Read details (will want commercial use)
- Read order details for extra gigs (this will tell you about the extras and how much they cost)
- How many gigs they have done (upper right corner)
- How many gigs in the queue
- Listen to samples
- Read reviews
- Contact them with question or custom order

Search podcast cover art or graphic design podcast

Refine results (left menu bar)

- Delivery time
- Price range
- Seller level
- Language
- Under this category, they will create cover art to itunes specs. (1400x1400 to 3000x3000) It should be 300 dpi (high resolution)

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When your order is delivered:

- Approve or ask for modification
- There may be a *fiverr* watermark or it will be on Amazon s3 until you approve it
- Get some feedback or another opinion before approving
- No need to ask for modification until the product is delivered
- Fiver is good about watching for late orders and will send you an email.
- Don't approve unless you are happy with it
- You attract more bees with honey than vinegar 😊
- Leave a review
- You can click the favorites to add them to your personal list for future reference
- You can always communicate with the seller through fiverr if you have questions or it's taking longer than expected.
