

God is everywhere—even *At The Movies*. While most of Hollywood may not intend to create movies with a spiritual message, numerous films show glimpses of God's presence and hold hints to biblical principles. All it takes is an open mind and heart to discover these truths. These questions can help start a discussion about the biblical truths you may have observed in any movie that you recently saw in the theater, at home, or during the *At The Movies* series. If you are leading a group through this guide, don't feel like you have to answer every question. Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

- Which character in the movie did you relate to most? Why?
- In what ways did the movie touch you on an emotional level?
- What specific biblical truths or themes did you observe in the movie?
- How were Christian principles reflected in the actions of the characters or in the story of the movie?
- What things in the movie did not reflect God's high standards of living? What can you learn from these actions and themes?
- What things in the movie did you find inspirational? How might you be moved to action?
- How could you use this movie to share God's truth and love with someone else?
- What quotes or themes were spiritual but maybe not biblical? What can your group do to search scripture to find the difference between the spirituality in the movie and God's view of things?
- What are some scriptures that discuss the truths or themes that you observed in the movie? Share these scriptures with your group or another person. (If you are having difficulty thinking of verses to use, consider using a concordance or an online Biblical reference tool that will help you find the verses you are looking for.)

## NEXT STEPS

Here are some specific things you can do to learn more about the biblical truths you learned from the movie:

Share the movie with someone you know that could benefit from the truths and themes you learned while watching it. If possible, watch the movie with that person and take time to discuss it with them afterwards using these questions. Also, read the verses from the Bible that discusses these truths.

Take time this week to study the scriptures and themes you learned from the movie. Incorporate them into your personal study time with God. Invite God to speak to you about the things you learned from the movie.
