Sample the local version of soto, a traditional Indonesian soup, served at this popular eatery. It's topped with either chicken, beef or offal, and best enjoyed with a side of perkedel (fried patties made with ground potato). 2 Jln Sei Deli



TINGGI RAJA WHITE CRATER
