Creative Finds at a Historic Place (H2)

Arts & Antiques Marketplace is not your usual art and antique shop. Owned and operated by Louis Spatafore and his wife Deloris, the gallery is housed at the historic Jacob's-Hutchinson Block Building. Designed by famous architect Andrew C. Lyons, the vintage building first opened in 1902. Hartley's Department Store occupied about half of the building until Jones Department Store took over and made it its home from 1928 to 1976. In 1978, Friendly Furniture Galleries started to occupy the place. Dodge Jewelers, Pettrey Shoes, First National Bank, Sharpe-Hamilton Men's Store, Henry's House of Shoes, L's Discount Lingerie, and Higginbotham & Higginbotham Law Office were the other businesses that occupied the place.

A Breath of Fresh Air (H2)

When Friendly Furniture Galleries closed its door in 2014, Lou felt afraid that the building might just be one of the many dilapidated structures in the area. They tried to market it, in the hopes of finding an interested developer who could convert it into a residential property but it did not take place. Then, he came up with a bright idea. He realized that since it was a historic building, it would be perfect for antiques, artworks, and other crafts. Several vendors showed their interest in leasing the space when he proposed his idea. Soon enough, they started one of the biggest and most successful collaborations among individual vendors in the history of Fairmont. With all the interesting items it has in store, along with the events taking place here, it continues to delight many people.
