Most of the thousands of cenotes scattered across Mexico's Yucatán peninsula are inaccessible to the public. Some have dangerously

slipshod access while others are swarmed by tourist buses. Head to the Santa Bárbara Cenotes an hour from Merida, with four swimmable cenotes – including an underground waterhole – for one entry fee.
