The Santos de Cartier watch is a cornerstone of modern horology, born from innovation and continually reimagined to suit the times. This latest evolution honors the origins of the iconic timepiece with the introduction of a refined small model, thoughtfully sized at 27 mm x 34.5 mm. Its proportions pay tribute to the earliest Santos watches created for pioneering aviator Alberto Santos-Dumont in 1904 — the very first modern wristwatch, designed for ease of use during flight.

Remaining faithful to the collection's style, this new interpretation preserves the aesthetic codes that have defined the Santos de Cartier for more than a century: a square case, visible screws, and fluid lines. The industrial nature of the screws contrast elegantly with the sophistication of the new sunray-effect dial, offering subtle radiance within a streamlined silhouette. Though more compact, this edition carries the same presence and polish as the larger Santos models.

Available in all-steel, yellow gold and steel, or solid yellow gold, the watches are powered by high-autonomy quartz movements, tailored to the smaller case dimensions. Each version is water-resistant to 30 meters and features Cartier's signature interchangeable strap system, allowing for effortless transitions between a bracelet and leather strap. The leather options, fitted with ardillon buckles, are crafted in smooth calfskin for the steel and two-tone models, and in alligator for the full gold edition.

A. Lange & Söhne introduced three new watches that highlight the brand's mechanical depth and distinctive aesthetics.

The Zeitwerk Date continues the evolution of the German watchmaker's digital-mechanical concept, featuring for the first time a gray dial within a 44.2 mm pink-gold case. Its signature oversized jumping-numbers display includes the hour window on the left and the minute window on the right, with the latter advancing precisely once every 60 seconds, powered by a constant-force escapement that regulates torque from the twin barrels. Around the dial, a ring-shaped glass date display advances each midnight — a technically demanding feature achieved through a secondary mechanism. Comprised of 516 components and visible through the sapphire-crystal caseback, the superbly finished, manually wound Caliber Lo43,8 delivers a 72-hour power reserve.

In contrast, the new 1815 models celebrate simplicity and tradition. Named after the birth year of founder Ferdinand Adolph Lange,

these elegant timepieces, offered in white or pink gold, feature compact 34 mm cases and pocket watch-inspired dials. The striking blue dials display central hour and minute hands with a small-seconds subdial at 6 o'clock. Inside is the newly developed Caliber L152.1, a hand-wound movement with a 72-hour power reserve, Glashütte ribbing on the three-quarter plate, and a hand-engraved balance cock — marking the 75th caliber created since the brand's revival in 1990.

Together, these releases underline Lange's approach: whether pursuing digital precision or traditional form, every detail is executed with the same uncompromising craftsmanship and technical integrity that define German high horology.

The supple, scale-like bracelet enhances comfort, while the opaline or pavé dials reflect Bulgari's jewelry *savoir-faire*.



First launched in 1955, the IWC Ingenieur was created as a tool watch for scientists and engineers, built around the brand's first automatic movement and designed to withstand magnetic fields. But it was in the 1970s, under the creative direction of legendary designer Gérald Genta, that the Ingenieur took on its now-iconic form. With its distinct, industrial design language, H-link integrated bracelet, grid-patterned dial, and screw-down bezel with five recesses, the 1976 Ingenieur SL redefined the collection as a player in the emerging category of luxury sports watches.

IWC EXPANDS THE INGENIEUR LINE WITH NEW MATERIALS, SIZES, AND COMPLICATIONS

Nearly 50 years later, IWC continues to reimagine the Ingenieur with updated materials, complications, and proportions, while staying true to the hallmarks established during the Genta era.

Since debuting the reengineered Ingenieur Automatic 40 a few years ago, the brand has expanded the collection to include new materials, various sizes, and even additional complications. This year, IWC introduces a batch of references, including the debut of a compact 35 mm case size, a full ceramic 42 mm model, a perpetual calendar version in steel, and two 40 mm releases: one in solid 18k gold and another in a movie-inspired green dial configuration. Taken together, these launches highlight the Ingenieur's continued importance as both a design classic and a platform for innovation.

Jaeger-LeCoultre expands the Reverso's legacy of duality with the new Reverso Tribute Geographic, introducing a newly developed in-house movement, Caliber 834. Presented in stainless steel or 18k pink gold (limited to 150 pieces), this model reinterprets the travel-time complication with a poetic twist: local time on one dial, world time on the other.

On the front, the sunray-brushed dial — deep blue for the steel model or chocolate brown for pink gold — balances a large date display, hour, minutes, and small seconds. Turning the case reveals the reverse dial, where 24 time zones encircle a luminous lacquered map rendered in graduated tones of blue or gray. The map is a miniature work of art with a laser-engraved steel disk filled by hand with lacquer to form oceans, then polished to achieve subtle depth and contrast.

Caliber 834, entirely designed and assembled within the Manufacture, integrates both the World Time and Grande Date complications in a shaped movement that fits the Reverso's rectangular case. Its 42-hour

power reserve and intuitive operation (via a hidden pusher between the lugs for one-hour jumps) underscore Jaeger-LeCoultre's mastery of technical skill.

True to the Reverso's polo origins, each watch is paired with two Casa Fagliano straps, handmade by the world-famous Argentinian bootmakers known for their polo and riding boots. The steel model comes with canvas-and-leather and full leather straps in blue, while the pink gold version includes golden-tan calfskin and black alligator straps.

Ninety-four years after its debut, the Reverso remains a symbol of innovation through form and function, with its swiveling case still serving as a canvas where horological ingenuity and artistry meet across time zones.

Created in 1972, the watch that would later become known as the Piaget Andy Warhol began as Reference 15102, powered by the innovative Beta 21 quartz movement. With its bold cushion-shaped 45 mm case framed by sweeping gadroons, it was a striking departure from the conservative luxury watches of the era. The design captured the attention of artist Andy Warhol, who went on to own seven Piaget watches and helped define the brand's jet-set Piaget Society spirit during the 1970s and 1980s.

In 2014, Piaget revived the 15102 design

and renamed it the Black Tie, retaining the same audacious proportions and signature gadrooned bezel. A decade later, the model was officially reintroduced as the Andy Warhol watch through a partnership with The Andy Warhol Foundation for the Visual Arts. Today, it stands as one of Piaget's most distinctive creations, with its sculptural gold case, curved bezel, and wide, architectural proportions remaining instantly recognizable design signatures.

The modern Andy Warhol collection showcases Piaget's dual identity as both

watchmaker and jeweler. Collectors can explore an evolving range of gold shades and ornamental stone dials, including tiger's eye, malachite, lapis lazuli, meteorite, and onyx. Some references reinterpret the icon with fresh textures and craftsmanship, from the Clou de Paris bezel to high-jewelry editions set with precious gems.

With a mix of artistry, personalization, and Piaget's in-house 501P1 automatic movement, the Andy Warhol watch continues to express the brand's creative freedom and enduring link to art and culture.

OVERSEAS RADIATES IN PINK GOLD

Vacheron Constantin's Overseas collection continues to bridge impeccable craftsmanship and everyday wearability. Presented entirely in 18k pink gold, two models — one proudly complicated, one elegantly compact — reinterpret the Maison's travel-inspired design with tone-on-tone harmony and intricate finishing.



Overseas Perpetual Calendar Ultra-Thin

A showcase of high horology expertise, the Overseas Perpetual Calendar Ultra-Thin pairs its 41.5 mm pink gold case and integrated bracelet with a matching sunburst dial.

A blue minutes track and blue Super-LumiNova details lend a subtle contrast to the warm monochromatic palette.

Inside, the Manufacture Caliber 1120 QP/1 measures just 4.05 mm thick yet integrates a perpetual calendar (day, date, month, and leap year indicator) and moon-phase display that requires no adjustment until the year 2100. Through the sapphire caseback, the 22k gold rotor engraved with a compass rose recalls the Overseas theme of exploration. Delivered with two additional rubber straps in blue and white, it can transition easily from refined to relaxed.



Overseas 35 mm Self-Winding

Compact yet luminous, the Overseas 35 mm in full pink gold radiates a distinct, jewel-like charm. Its golden sunburst-lacquered dial echoes the tone of the pink gold case and integrated bracelet, while 90 round-cut diamonds on the Maltese Cross-inspired bezel trace a subtle cuff-style silhouette. Powered by the self-winding Caliber 1088/1, visible through the sapphire crystal caseback, the watch delivers a 40-hour power reserve and magnetic protection. Like the larger model, it includes interchangeable straps, in white calfskin leather and white rubber, allowing a shift from sophisticated to sporty with ease. This smaller Overseas captures the modern spirit of travel through light, texture, and craftsmanship.





Ulysse Nardin

Freak S Enamel

Ulysse Nardin continues to redefine mechanical watchmaking with the new Freak S Enamel, a dazzling evolution of its most radical creation. First introduced in 2001, the Freak broke every rule — no dial, no crown, no hands — replacing convention with a movement that rotates to tell time. Nearly a quarter of a century later, the Freak S takes this spirit of innovation even further, now presented for the first time with hand-crafted enamel artistry.

Limited to 50 pieces each, the Freak S Enamel debuts in two striking editions: vibrant turquoise blue and deep ruby red. The rotating hour disk, made of 18k white gold, is decorated with guilloché and finished with translucent enamel produced in-house at Donzé Cadrans, Ulysse Nardin's historic enameling workshop in Le Locle.

Every disk undergoes multiple firings at 800°C and meticulous hand-polishing to achieve its luminous depth and resilience. Every step of the enameling process carries inherent risks; bubbling, cracking, or uneven firing means having to start over from scratch. This demanding discipline allows no shortcuts, which is why enamel remains one of the most challenging materials to master in high horology. This is a particularly extraordinary feat given that it's a moving mechanical component, and not merely decorative.

Inside the 45 mm titanium case beats the Manufacture Caliber UN-251, a technical marvel with two inclined silicon balance wheels, a vertical differential, and the revolutionary Grinder automatic winding system. Ninety-five percent of the watch's 373 components are in motion, creating a mesmerizing mechanical display.

By uniting cutting-edge engineering with centuries-old craft, the Freak S Enamel illustrates Ulysse Nardin's enduring philosophy that progress in watchmaking happens when innovation and artistry move in unison.

EXPANDS ITS LUNAR LEGACY

Omega's latest Speedmaster Dark and Grey Side of the Moon watches mark the next evolution of its space-inspired chronographs, combining advanced ceramic engineering with subtly updated case profiles, dial colors, and movements.

The Speedmaster Dark Side of the Moon appears in five new variations, all featuring 44.25 mm black ceramic cases. Two automatic editions powered by the automatic Co-Axial Master Chronometer Caliber 9900 sport black dials accented in white and red, offered on either a black rubber strap or a black coated nylon strap. Two additional versions — also driven by Caliber 9900 and available on black rubber or black nylon — adopt a fully blacked-out aesthetic with darkened components and sandblasted dials. Completing the lineup is a slimmer model powered by the hand-wound Caliber 9908, distinguished by the red-tipped chronograph seconds

hand and red Speedmaster signature on its sandblasted black dial.


The Speedmaster Grey Side of the Moon shifts focus to texture and a lighter palette. Its 44.25 mm grey ceramic case houses the manually wound Caliber 3869, which features a laser-ablated lunar surface visible through both sides of the watch. The near side of the Moon appears between the skeletonized grey dial, while the far side emerges through the sapphire caseback — a tribute to Apollo 8 and the astronaut Jim Lovell's description of the Moon as "essentially grey." Each version is offered on either a grey rubber or grey nylon strap, complementing the watch's monochromatic style.

With advanced ceramic construction, updated calibers, and clear references to the brand's lunar heritage, these seven new chronographs demonstrate Omega's ongoing evolution of the Speedmaster line.

When Love Goes the Distance: Sandra & Santiago's Journey to Each Other


