In a city of *très chic* choices, these are the new Parisian boutiques to know.

❶ Once known for hosiery and baby clothes, **Molli** is entering a new chapter under creative director Charlotte de Fayet that includes a fresh flagship off the Champs-Élysées and a sophisticated collection of ready-to-wear fine-knit trousers, jacquard skirts, and matching tops.

❷ Subtlety is not in founder and creative director Charaf Tajer's wheelhouse, as evidenced across **Casablanca's** rue du Faubourg Saint-Honoré outpost. The brand's French Moroccan roots and Tajer's love for Japanese subculture come through in pieces that blend comfort and edginess.

❸ **Martin Martin's** ultra-feminine universe of slinky dresses, slouchy trousers, and tailored jackets now has a home in Saint-Germain-des-Prés. The jewel-box boutique, with herringbone wood floors and gilded accents, is as sexy as Capucine Martin's designs.

❹ Paris firm Studio KO designed the new Marais flagship of **Ami Paris**, a light-filled, two-story space with mirrored accents and minimalist displays of Alexandre Mattiussi's elevated T-shirts, sweaters, jeans, and accessories, many adorned with the brand's signature heart.
