Students, clubs, Scout groups and others are welcome. Community service hours available. For information, please call 951-693-2814.



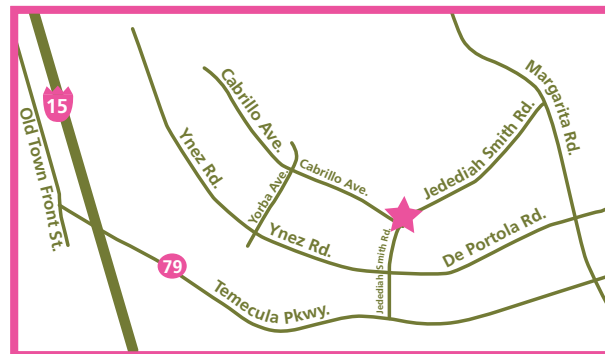
Rose Haven Heritage Garden

The Temecula Valley Rose Society owns and maintains the Rose Haven Heritage Garden in Temecula. This beautiful garden is open daily from dawn to dusk year-round for the public to enjoy.

The garden features about 2,000 roses: hybrid teas, floribundas, climbers and mini roses, plus a drought-tolerant garden and reflecting pond. Workshops held at Rose Haven in January and February are open to the public and focus on pruning; spring activities include planting and fertilizing. Visitors are always welcome.

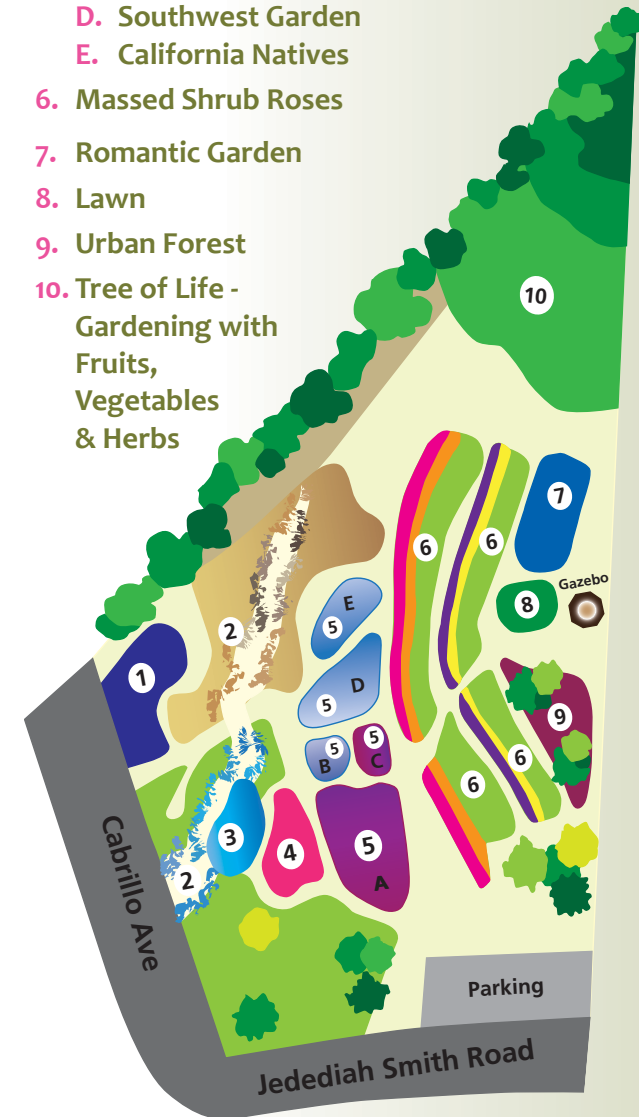
To get to Rose Haven from Rancho California Road, take Ynez Road south to Jedediah Smith Road and turn left. From Temecula Parkway (Highway 79 South), take Jedediah Smith Road north two blocks.
