
Faith Baptist Church 'IF THE LORD WILLS" FAITH BAPTIST CHURCH STRATEGIC MINISTRY PLAN



Who we are...

Faith Baptist Church is a family of followers of Jesus Christ who desire to honor God by applying His sufficient Word to all areas of life and ministry. We seek to do this by growing stronger, reaching out, serving together, meeting needs, and strengthening others.

OUR MISSION

*Our proposed initiatives starting on this page and continuing on the following pages are organized around these values.

GROWING STRONGER

- Evaluate the structure and effectiveness of our current ABF ministries as they relate to building relationships, assimilating newcomers, and equipping believers for growth.
- Consider ways that parents and youth leaders can partner to develop and carry out a plan for each young person's spiritual growth.
- Continue to promote hospitality among our church family by encouraging families to invite others for lunch after church.
- 4. Present a teaching series on the principles of worship. Consider ways to strengthen our worship.

REACHING OUT

- Develop snow removal, lawn mowing, and house cleaning services for single mothers, disabled persons, elderly persons, etc.
- 2. Develop additional ways to use sports as an outreach tool.
- Explore how we can better understand and aid the work of each missionary we support—especially missionaries we have sent.
- 4. Update the Passion Play script and presentation.

SERVING TOGETHER


- 1. Continue to develop training for lay people that helps to identify their spiritual gifts.
- Review teen youth worker recruitment and training, and implement any needed improvements.
- Continue to develop the Human Resource Coordinator position.
- 4. Evaluate the current stewardship commitment card.

MEETING NEEDS

- Craft a philosophy statement regarding groups with whom we would be willing to partner.
- 2. Promote free parenting classes to the community.
- Explore additional ways to work with and support Trinity Mission

STRENGTHENING OTHERS

- Develop materials to help other churches start a biblical counseling center.
- 2. Make digital audio available on the internet.
- 3. Install cameras in some of our counseling offices to enhance training programs.





GROWING STRONGER

- Consider offering additional Life Application Class topics at a variety
 of times throughout the week both on-site and off. Additional topics
 to consider include an overview of the Bible, creationism, time
 management, counseling training, leadership, organization, and Bible
 study basics, along with previously offered classes.
- 2. Develop a discipleship plan for those pursuing careers in the ministry.
- 3. Continue to develop our mentoring program.
- 4. Develop a scripture memory program for our church family.

REACHING OUT

- Consider ways to lead the church in extending hospitality to our visitors and neighbors. This may include offering a monthly lunch for visitors and key church leaders, or developing a network of families who would be willing to contact visitors (and recurring attenders) and invite them over for dinner.
- Develop plans for more mission trips and consider sending medical and construction teams overseas.
- 3. Consider ways to strengthen our outreach to the Purdue campus.
- Offer 6–8 week Sunday evening preaching series on topics of interest to people in our community.

SERVING TOGETHER

- Explore why people are hesitant to serve in long-term serving opportunities. Develop strategies to address these concerns.
- 2. Develop a strategy for helping people move from lay counseling training into actual counseling cases.
- Review Sunday school teacher recruitment and training, and implement any needed improvements.
- Develop a database that tracks the service desires and service positions of persons associated with our ministry.

MEETING NEEDS

- 1. Offer community oriented classes for computer skills, GED prep, etc.
- Consider further promotion of lay counseling service to our congregation and community.
- Develop a summer school program that would provide assistance to children who have struggled academically during the school year. Structure classes to include Scripture lessons as well as teaching on study habits.

STRENGTHENING OTHERS

- Consider ways to promote the materials of the Ministry Resource Center to the Christian community.
- Develop a children's Clubs program that is documented in manuals, lesson plans, and teaching aids and make the program available for other churches on the internet.
- Implement and refine a deacon training program to be used by prospective deacons in other churches.

2005 FBC PROPOSED INITIATIVES

GROWING STRONGER

- 1. Develop a youth version of the counseling training notes.
- 2. Consider ways to strengthen our Children's Ministries.
- 3. Explore ways to strengthen our church's prayer ministries.
- Develop new ways to communicate the value and availability of Life Application Classes to people in our church and in our community.

REACHING OUT

- Develop a strategy for attracting people to our church who might not otherwise consider attending Sunday services through community game nights, theatrical productions, neighborhood dessert tastings, book discussions, candidate debates, family movie nights, etc.
- Support current missionaries at higher financial levels so that furlough is a time of rest and training.
- 3. Consider making the Pig Roast a community/neighborhood event.
- 4. Explore ways to improve accessibility of Evangelism Training classes.

SERVING TOGETHER

- Develop a resource/supply room for teachers with craft materials, games, etc.
- 2. Review Clubs worker recruitment and training, and implement any needed improvements.
- Improve the curriculum and teaching tools for Clubs and Children's Church.
- 4. Consider ways to train more ABF teachers.


MEETING NEEDS

- 1. Consider ways to work with local crisis pregnancy ministries.
- 2. Develop a summer fine arts program for community youth.
- 3. Teach and equip people to write loving letters to influence public opinion.

STRENGTHENING OTHERS

- 1. Lay groundwork for establishment of a church-based seminary.
- 2. Share Life Application Classes with other churches and missionaries.
- 3. Share the futures planning process with other churches.

GROWING STRONGER

- 1. Develop a more systematic approach to our current Men's Ministries.
- Find ways to improve our ministry to shut-ins and to other senior saints.
- Explore creative ways to minister to families with children in public schools.
- 4. Expand the number of lay counselors.

REACHING OUT

- Develop programs to help believers transition from corporate outreaches into personal evangelism opportunities.
- Expand our ministry to minority groups by offering legal counseling, intensive ESL classes, sports outreach, etc.
- Develop a high quality video that includes a clear explanation of the gospel.
- Develop regular phone hook-ups and online message board communication with our missionary families.

SERVING TOGETHER

- Consider ways to strengthen communication concerning service opportunities.
- Review nursery worker recruitment and training, and implement any needed improvements.
- Review key leader recruitment and training, and implement any needed improvements.
- 4. Develop Human Resources Coordinator position in each ABF.

MEETING NEEDS

- Explore additional ways to work with and support Habitat for Humanity.
- Develop a long-term program for jail ministry that includes transitional housing for released prisoners.
- 3. Develop a program for teen job training.

STRENGTHENING OTHERS

- Develop a concrete plan to impact area churches with the message of the sufficiency of Scripture.
- Host training seminars for pastors and missionaries on futures planning, deacon training, and other areas of local church life.
- Develop a program for aiding missionaries that receive counseling from our ministry.

- Has clear evidence of spiritual growth in specific areas of life.


THIRD BASE— COMMITTED TO SERVICE

REACHING OUT

- Further develop a fine arts program that regularly produces quality family-oriented dramas onsite and quality evangelistic dramas for our community at neutral venues like the Long Center or Tippecanoe Amphitheatre.
- Develop a series of one-day seminars/conferences with a focus on specific vocations that help people to apply the scriptures in their work places.
- 3. Consider ways to more effectively use VBS as an outreach tool.
- Write a philosophy statement for missionary involvement and support.

SERVING TOGETHER

- Develop a mentoring/coaching philosophy in staffing all of our ministries.
- 2. Improve the service sign-up process through the use of the internet and ministry sign-up boards.
- Review music ministry recruitment and training, and implement any needed improvements.
- 4. Integrate a greater number of older, mature Christians in teaching.


MEETING NEEDS
