SEEING MORE CLEARLY; MINISTRY CATEGORIES To better integrate all of our ministries in the 2018-2022

plan, we've created five categories to reflect the diversity of our outreach and service:

LOCAL CHURCH MINISTRY: Initiatives impacting local church ministry, worship, communication, children's ministry, Bible studies, and small and large group fellowship.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT: Initiatives focusing on youth and family engagement through community activities, sports and training located in our community and neighborhood centers.

BIBLICAL COUNSELING: Features initiatives designed to help us improve mentoring, short-term and residential counseling, and counseling training in the US and throughout the world, but especially in Latin America.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION: Initiatives proposed by Faith Bible Seminary and Faith Christian School including adult training, primary and secondary education, partnerships, and international outreach.

GLOBAL MISSIONS: Initiatives to grow and support missionaries, short-term mission projects, international outreach, and leadership training.

Local Church Ministries

Determine the ministry model for Faith Church North including the potential for Saturday night and Spanish services.

Consider ways to enhance our corporate worship by adding variety to the content and structure of our services.

Explore the possibility of producing an original Passion Play annually.

Expand evangelistic neighborhood Bible studies in the north end.

Evaluate and determine improvements to our current visitor connection process.

Consider hosting additional VBS and Winter Break ministries at Faith West and the Northend Community Center.

Community Engagement

Develop a program for youth engagement in conjunction with the launch of the Northend Community Center.

Launch expanded Car Works program and ministry.

Consider developing affordable rentals in the north end.

Increase the percentage of the church family serving on a regular basis in Community Ministries.

Work to integrate north end youth into the Faith Neighborhood Service Team.

Consider establishing a variety of running and bike clubs in the north end.

Develop entire spectrum of sports ministries at Northend Community Center.

Increase the variety of water-based activities for pools, including swim lessons, lifeguard training, and look for ways to partner with the YWCA and minimize duplication of services.

Biblical Counseling

Continue to pursue state licensure and a financial contract for a residential home to help victims of human trafficking

Consider expanding the availability of community counseling to additional days of the week.

Consider building the second duplex on the property at Bethany Farms.

Develop a strategy for ongoing ministry in Mexico, Cuba, and the Dominican Republic.



Consider ways to improve the connection between our mentoring ministries and our counseling ministries.

Seek to increase the ministry activity at the Bethany Farms property.

Create and market a new series of counseling observation videos in English and Spanish.

Work with ACBC to ensure that a Spanish only speaking person can

complete the certification process.

Finalize the Reclaimed Hope storefront

at the Northend Community Center. Consider ways to improve our advertis-

ing material and mailing distribution from Faith Resources.

Christian Education

Consider launching an online Bachelor's completion degree in Biblical Counseling through FBS.

Establish connections with partnering churches in the Dominican Republic, Mexico, Cuba, and Brazil in order to aid in training men for ministry through FBS.

Begin FCS expansion project at the Faith East campus to provide additional classroom space and enhance building safety.

Consider ways to strengthen partnership between FCS and Queretaro Christian School in Mexico.

Global Missions

Assist in supporting New Life Church in Congo to strengthen the current offerings of the Congo Coalition's 'Entrust' training program.

Consider Global Missions focused Church Family Night for missionary presentations, short-term trip awareness, and prayer.

Develop short-term summer internship programs with global missions partners for young adults interested in cross-cultural ministry.

Expand partnerships with Chinese churches for international students returning to China.

2019

Consider renovating the south end of the Faith East church building to enhance Children's Ministries.

Consider making renovations to the Faith East foyer and nursery wing.

Consider how Sunday morning worship services could be adapted to best serve each parish.



Consider establishing a simple method for communicating how a person can grow spiritually through the ministries of our church.

Seek to build and strengthen relationships within our church by better integrating small group ministries into existing adult ministries and encouraging members to be actively involved.

Seek to increase awareness among our church family of community resources available for families in need.

Community Engagement

Consider partnering with local service providers to expand the outreach of the Faith Neighborhood Service Team to include more household maintenance for home owners who need help and cannot afford to hire the help.

Develop a business and sustainability plan for our undeveloped property at Faith East.

Provide leadership to launch the Northend Coalition.

Consider forming a film production ministry. Begin exploring the idea of a north end

5K run.

Ensure that Faith Community Ministries provides a continuum of quali

tries provides a continuum of quality services across all three campuses through centralized training of staff.

Expand outreach into all north end neighborhoods through regular play days and block parties.

Work to fund, update, and repair skate park.

Biblical Counseling

Consider making counseling available for children in our community who do not have a supportive home structure.

Increase the number of Spanish-speaking counselors serving at Faith by four. The goal is to produce a "working model" in both English and Spanish.

Consider how to use the Northend Community Center to maximize the effectiveness of the BCTC.

Consider how to improve our continuing education for counselors.

Consider recruiting additional Spanish-speaking teachers who can help us fulfill the many requests from the Hispanic world.

Build and develop the Restoration Sawmilling business.

Seek to train and deploy 8-10 counselors to serve those in our Restoration Ministry.

Develop the awareness and ministry of Reclaimed Hope.

Determine the best way to make resources available to our church family now that there are three campuses.

Relocate the seminary library to the Northend Community Center and make needed changes to continue to have an excellent bookstore, library, and resource center at Faith East.

Consider developing a Servant Leadership Training program for graduates of the Restoration Ministry.

Consider launching Track 1 counseling training in a 4th Spanish-speaking country.

Consider expanding our regional conference ministry to include 5 sites around the country.

Consider expanding the international intern program at Vision of Hope.

Consider expanding the number of Faith Church interns being trained by FBS.

Consider how to partner with Word of Life graduates to enable the students to complete their bachelor's degree.

Effectively connect ministry opportunities for FCS students within the ministries of Faith Church.

Consider launching a satellite school in the north end.
