#### Introduction

There are several reasons why I am advocating for personal mentoring.

- 1. Personal meetings are beneficial to the mentors and to your church.
- 2. Personal meetings are beneficial to the couple.
- 3. Personal meetings accomplish something classes cannot.

There are eight principles that I want every one of my couples to think about before they marry.

#### Principle #1: Jesus must be the Center of your life

  - $\rightarrow$  Jesus gave them a new identity.

    (Romans 8:31-35)
  - $\rightarrow$  Jesus is their spouse's ONLY hero.

### B. How can their marriage be the proper picture of C h r i s t and the church?

- → Marital harmony and marital challenge can often be summarized by w o r s h i p .
- → When you love Jesus first, you will be prepared to love your spouse.
- → Person ... Partner ... Parent ... If you do not have the person part right, it is very hard to be a godly spouse.
