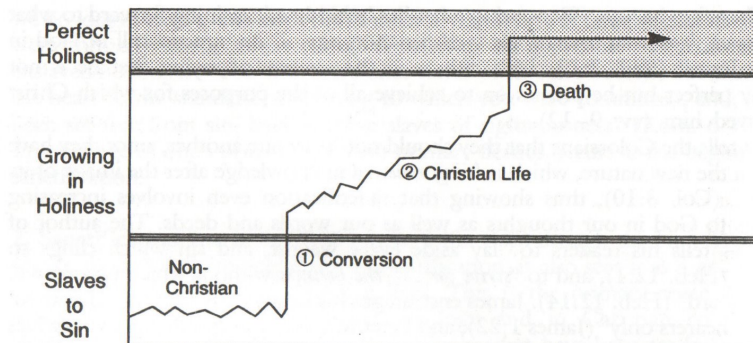

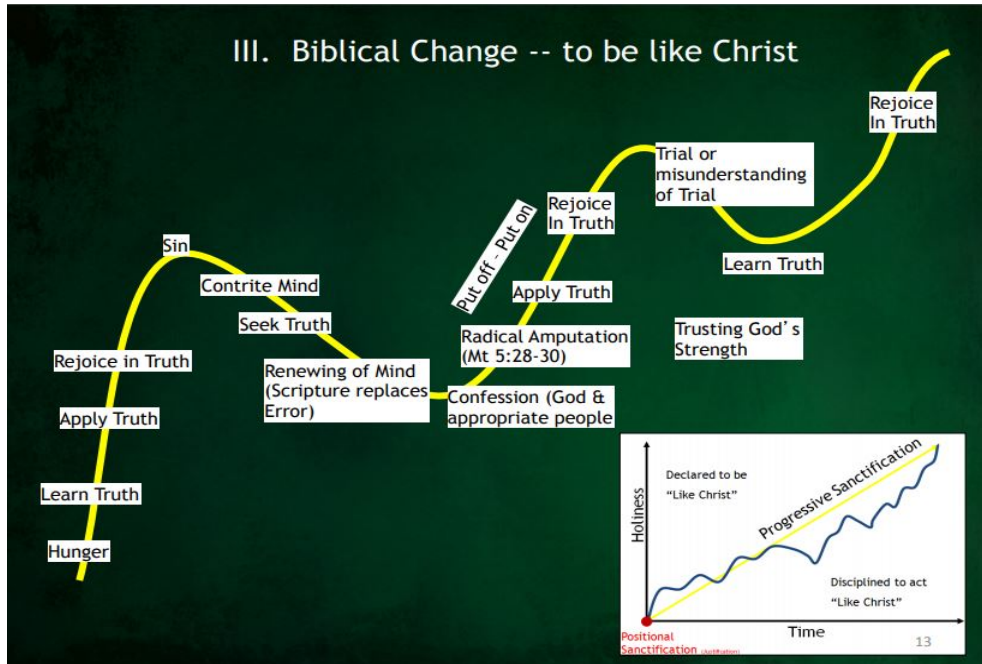


THE PROCESS OF SANCTIFICATION
