THE ROLE AT A GLANCE:

The Pastor of Biblical Counseling provides spiritual, administrative, and leadership for the Biblical counseling ministry here at Cornerstone Bible Church. This role ensures that counseling services are biblically faithful, ethically sound, and organizationally effective. The POBC oversees counselors, develops training and procedures, provides wisdom-based leadership, and supports the long-term health and growth of the counseling ministry at CBC.

- Lead the Spiritual wellbeing of the Ministry, the Office Manager, and it's counselors well as unto the Lord. (1 Cor. 10:31)
- Support the Senior Pastor in carrying out the mission and vision of the church.
- Ensure counseling practices align with Scripture, church doctrine and organizational standards.
- Provide leadership, wisdom and encouragement to the Biblical Counseling staff.
- Create and implement strategies for all biblical counseling programs, classes, counseling cases, and conferences.
- Support and encourage ACBC certification of all Biblical counselors.
- Develop an ongoing plan to enlist, train, and nurture staff and volunteer counselors.
- Coordinate alignment of vision, values and strategies within our Biblical Counseling Ministry, Home Fellowship Groups, and Congregational Care Ministry.
- Serve as a Biblical counselor to individuals, couples and families as needed.
- Conduct Initial Counseling Appointments.
- Conduct and review case reports to ensure sound Biblical methodology, clarity and accountability.
- Attend an ACBC Conference each year.
- Oversee CBC's annual Biblical Counseling Conference
- Work towards becoming an ACBC Certified Training Center by end of 2028.
- Develop and review the yearly Counseling Ministry budget, monitor expenses and assist with planning for future ministry growth.
- Fulfill other pastoral duties as needed.
- Oversee Home Fellowship Groups and Congregational Care Ministry, Discipleship Ministry, and Assimilation.
