- b. In the meantime, stand firm, let nothing move you.

\*1 Corinthians 15:19-27a

- a. Affirmation that death is our enemy. It's not right and we don't have to pretend that it is o.k.
- b. Great hope in the knowledge that Christ has done something about it.
- \*Psalm 23
- a. God is with me in the valley of the shadow of death.

\*John 14:1-6a

a. In the meantime, our home is being prepared for us while we are being prepared for our home.
