Trey Garner's Key Initiatives – 2017

 - Work with Jeremy Vegter to improve our Children's Ministries web presence.
 - Consider producing electronic and print literature to better acquaint families to our ministry.
 - Consider ways in which we might provide better "customer service" to children and parents.
 - Work with servants to improve the effectiveness of our visitor follow-up process.
 - Work with Pastor Heim in training greeters to effectively serve visiting families.
 - Work with our Tech Director and Head Greeter to determine if, where, and how we could register new families for Children's Ministries in the foyer.
 - d. Lead the members of Faith Church to a greater love and commitment to serving families.
 - Lead the SERVE '17 campaign to provide for full staffing for our Nursery and Children's Ministries through the end of the 2016-17 school-year.
 - Employ and equip a part-time church assistant to recruit, train, and deploy church members into service within our Children's Ministries.
 - Recruit, equip, and deploy servants to serve in the following key positions:
 - 11:00 Nursery Coordinator
 - Wednesday Night Kids of Faith Coordinator
 - 9:30 Nursery Coordinator
 - Servant Appreciation Coordinator
 - Consider deploying drama teams to present lessons within our Children's Ministry classrooms (Faith Church annual initiative).
 - Consider offering Special Needs training (Faith Church annual initiative).
 - Continue seeking to build a stronger sense of community among classroom servants.
 - Build relationships with potential servants by participating in the Introduction to Faith class sessions and dinners for Faith East.
 - Conduct an appreciation event for classroom servants and ministry leaders.
 - Consider conducting a survey of servants to learn how we could improve their experience.
 - e. Equip Children's Ministries servants to serve with excellence.
 - Investigate avenues for more effectively training Nursery and Children's Ministries servants.
 - Lead Stephen Thomas and Micah Stockdale to create and/or refine administrative checklists for the areas of ministry they have overseen.
 - Continue helping our Children's Ministries servants to develop a parish outreach mindset.

- Work with the Children's Ministries interns in surveying other churches to establish a compendium of best practices for teacher training. Consider adaptations for our ministry.
- Consider improvements to the weekly discipleship resources we provide for our servants.

- Consider improvements to the ways in which we equip parents to use our Children's Ministries' teaching for the discipleship of their children.
