## Faith Church Missions Key Initiatives – 2017

- 1. Implement Missions communication initiative for building missionary awareness to Faith Church family across all Faith Church campuses.
  - a. Show missionary videos at least 2 times per month.
- 2. Establish missions committee to advise and assist the pastors and deacons in accomplishing the mission initiatives of Faith Church.
- 3. Improve missionary care for all Faith Church campuses by providing resources, planning, updates, and prayer.
  - a. Consider implementing missionary selected care groups.
  - b. Consider Christmas letter writing or missionary wish-list offering.
  - c. Consider have missions focused ABF teaching time with missionary video/skype.
  - d. Explore summer ministry internship programs.
- 4. Improve and expand Faith Church Short Term Mission Trips that are coordinated with Church Mission initiatives and strategic partnerships.
  - a. Consider planning quarterly trips with graduated difficulty or commitment levels.
  - b. Improve Short Term Trip communication and increase trip involvement.
  - c. Consider local short term learning trips at Faith Church for outside partners.
- 5. Achieve greater financial and ministerial scale for the purpose of better stewardship and missionary care for FGM.
  - a. Identify specific combinations of geographic and ministry needs for our existing missionaries; and communicating those needs both online and at conferences including the BCTC.
  - b. Display a booth at the BCTC and building new relationships with the church leaders who attend.
  - c. Find help with the creation of content for social media; to promote brand and mission awareness; to increase the number of inquiries we receive from missionary prospects.
  - d. Hold an FGM prospect dinner at the BCTC.
  - e. Get to know the Faith West pastors & encourage them to be sensitive to students within their spheres of influence (particularly international students) who may be called to be missionaries.
  - f. Identify & exhibiting at 1 -2 other conferences in 2017 and building relationships with church leaders.
  - g. Recruit a minimum of 4 new missionaries in 2017 who will work in the same ministry as current FGM missionaries in their geographic locations.
  - h. Master our process of taking a potential missionary from prospective to productive; including writing how I want the process to flow and creating the forms I need for the process.
- 6. Find training solutions that prepare our missionaries for effective ministry without draining FGMs limited resources (examples: language, experiencing culture shock, counseling training, and theological training):
  - a. Meet church and missions leaders as well as missionaries at various conferences.
  - b. Create a rigorous training experience that occurs in a foreign mission field for an interim period so that if a missionary is going to quit they will do so before we invest too many resources into them.
