A. The terrifying of the Lord		
<b>Hebrews 10:26-27</b> - For if we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a terrifying expectation of judgment and the fury of a fire which will consume the adversaries.

<b>Hebrews 10:28-29</b> - Anyone who has set aside the Law of Moses dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses.
