## FIXING OUR HEARTS ON JESUS GOD APPROVES THOSE WHO LIVE BY FAITH

Hebrews 11:17-40

### Hebrews 12:1-3

**Hebrews 11:1** - Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

**Hebrews 11:2** - For by it [faith] the men of old gained approval.

**Hebrews 11:6** - And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

**Hebrews 11:16** - But as it is, they desire a better country, that is, a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God; for He has prepared a city for them.

**Hebrews 11:39-40** - And all these, having gained approval through their faith, did not receive what was promised, because God had provided something better for us, so that apart from us they would not be made perfect.

**Hebrews 11:7** - By faith Noah, being warned by God about things not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household, by which he condemned the world, and became an heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

**Hebrews 11:17,19** - By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was offering up his only begotten son ... He considered that God is able to raise people even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type.

**Hebrews 11:23** - By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw he was a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's edict.

**Hebrews 11:31** - By faith Rahab the harlot did not perish along with those who were disobedient, after she had welcomed the spies in peace.
