Galatians 2:20-21

4 reasons that explain why our hearts should be fixed on Jesus
Reason #1 - Christ Granted Us Over the Power and Penalty of Sin (2:20a)
Galatians 2:20a - I have been crucified with Christ
A. We were crucified means we to ourselves
B. With Christ means that believers are in with Jesus
Romans 6:5-7 - For if we have become united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection, knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; for he who has died is freed from sin.
Reason #2 - Christ Makes Our Heart His (2:20b)
Galatians 2:20b and it is no longer I who live but Christ lives in me
Ephesians 3:14-17 - For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.
Reason #3 - Our Lives to Him
Galatians 2:20c - and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by

faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Reason #4 - We Need to ______ _ _ God's Grace by Emphasizing Christ's Worthwhile Death

Galatians 2:21 - I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly.

Acts 4:12 - And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.

2 Thessalonians 1:7-10 - ... the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, when He comes to be glorified in His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed.
