Romans 5:1-11

Four Principles of Stewardship

1. God owns everything, you own nothing.
2. God entrusts you with everything you have.
3. You can either increase or diminish what God has given; He wants you to increase it.
4. God can call you into account at any time, and it may be today.

I. Jesus Made _____ With God Possible (5:1)

Romans 5:1 - *Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ...*

A. Justification = Declared _____ (5:1)

Justification is the judicial act of God whereby He declares the sinner innocent and imputes the righteousness of Christ to his account.

1. Even when we were sinners (5:8)

Romans 5:8 - *But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.*

2. Even when we were under the wrath of God (5:9)

Romans 5:9 - *Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.*

Romans 5:2 - *...through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.*
