Luke 19:2 - *There was a man called by the name of Zaccheus, he was a chief tax collector and he was rich.*

C. Zaccheus was wealthy, yet _____.

Luke 19:3-4 - *Zaccheus was trying to see who Jesus was, and was unable because of the crowd, for he was small in stature. So he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree in order to see Him, for He was about to pass through that way.*

Matthew 13:44-45 - *The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found and hid again; and from joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.*

1 John 1:7 - *...if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.*

Luke 19:8 - *Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I will give to the poor..."*

2. Greater restitution than is required

Luke 19:8 - *Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I will give to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will give back four times as much."*

Philippians 3:8 - *More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ...*

C. Zaccheus received the gift of _____ life

Luke 19:10 - *And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."*
