SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON : JUNE 18

Title: Abraham and Sarah Doubt God

Passage: Genesis 16:1-6; 17:15-21; 18:1-15

Principle: Nothing can stop God's plans.

Praise: "Father Abraham"*

Prompt: Ask your child these questions:

- What did God promise Abraham and Sarah?
- How old were Abraham and Sarah?
- Did God fulfill His promise through Sarah or through Hagar?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By trusting God's promises, even if they seem impossible.
- By being patient for God to fulfill His promises.

This week: As a family, read Genesis 16:1-6; 17:15-21; 18:1-15.

Next week: Genesis 18:16-19:29

Memory verses: "And I will make you a great nation, and **I will bless you**, and make your name great; and **so you shall be a blessing**; and I will bless those who bless you, and the one who curses you I will curse. **And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed.**" Genesis 12:2-3*

In Christ Alone Handling Problems in a Christ-Centered Way Understanding and Handling Worry in a Christ-Centered Way Matthew 6:19-34, Philippians 4:4-9

1) _____ Worry

- The root word comes from a Greek word that means "to divide or tear." Worry can be described as a "divided mind" that rips/tears at our soul. It is a fearful preoccupation with perceived loss or harm that might come my way
- Worry is idolatry—fearing the loss of earthly pleasures and treasures
Matthew 6:19, 24-25
- Worry is unbelief—failing to trust in the goodness of your Heavenly Father
Matthew 6: 30-32
Worry is appropriate for spiritual orphans but not children of the King
- Worry is laziness—it's like trying to go somewhere in a rocking chair but not as soothing! Worry will prevent you from directing your energy towards handling today's issues and appropriately planning for tomorrow
Matthew 6: 27, 34

2) _____ for Worry

- Know that God desires his children to be characterized by singleness of mind, peace, a quiet soul, a stable disposition
Matthew 6: 22
John 14:27
Philippians 4:6-7
- Seek God for your security and not the false security of earthly pleasures and treasures
Matthew 6:33
- Trust God in caring for you despite circumstances
Matthew 6:30-32
Isaiah 26:3 - *The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, because he trusts in You*
- Solve today's problems today and appropriately plan for tomorrow
Matthew 6:27, 34
- Practical Steps—when you begin to feel the angst
 - Stop and think through (or write out) what is the circumstance that is disturbing your soul
 - Distinguish between worry and appropriate concern

Useless Worry	Biblical Need Meeting
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Focus on “my loss”• Fear-based• Self-oriented• Inactive• Despair• Faithless (as indicated by prayerlessness, untrue thinking, and inaction)• Drains you and others	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Focus on a need• Love-based• Solution-oriented• Active• Hopeful• Faith (indicated by prayer, true thinking, and action)• Edifies you and others

- iii. List mentally (or on paper) what earthly comfort, pleasure, treasure, or security you fear you might lose or not have
- iv. Contrast the earthly security you fear losing to God’s promised security you cannot lose to recognize your idolatry and confess it
- v. Identify how you are not believing God’s promises to care for you and confess your unbelief.
- vi. Rehearse God’s promises to care for His children and walk with them through trials
- vii. Work to solve today’s problems and plan for tomorrow
 1. Pray for your concern
 2. Set out to solve the concern biblically if it is within your control
 3. Determine how to love the people involved in your concern biblically and do so
 4. Make a plan for potential future concerns
- viii. Repeat until you wrestle your noisy soul into a quiet soul

3) **The Basis for Supernatural Peace—The _____ of the presence of God with you always: Christ took your lack of peace (separation from God) so that you might have peace with God forever.**

Philippians 4:4-9

Acts 16:25-30

Jesus Christ, willing, chose the lack of peace (separation from His Father) so that you and I could have peace—the promise of being with God forever.

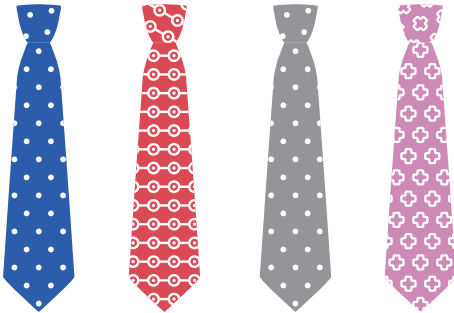


CALEB’S KIN (SENIOR CITIZENS)
