## SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON : OCTOBER 29

**Title:** God Ordains the Sacrificial System

**Passage:** Leviticus 1-7

**Principle:** God's holiness requires a sacrifice for sin

**Praise:** "Trust and Obey"

**Prompt:** Ask your child these questions:

- What types of offerings did the Israelites give to God?
- Why did the Israelites offer sacrifices?
- How was the worshiper forgiven?
- Who is the perfect sacrifice?

**Practice:** Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By trusting Jesus to take his punishment
- By living a holy life by obeying parents and leaders
- By praising God by giving Him the best effort and attitude
