



Title: God Promises Blessings or Curses **Passage:** Deuteronomy 11:8–17; 28:20

Principle: God blesses obedience and punishes

disobedience

Praise: "Trust and Obey"

Prompt: Ask your child these questions:

- What did Israel have to do to receive God's blessing?
- What would happen if Israel disobeyed God?
- How did God promise to bless or curse Israel?
- How can you be obedient to God?
- Are there consequences for disobedience today?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By demonstrating his love for God through obedience to His Word
- By remembering God's blessings and mercies
- By memorizing God's Word
- By honoring God in all he does
