Being Careful How We Build The Transforming Power of God's "Foolishness" 1 Corinthians 1:11-13, 17-31

When Paul came to Corinth, notice how he describes his demeanor: 1 Corinthians 2:1 - ...and when I came to you, brethren, I did not come with superiority of speech or of wisdom, proclaiming to you the testimony of God.

Notice how the Scriptures describe Paul's successor Apollos: Acts 18:24-25 - Now a Jew named Apollos, an Alexandrian by birth, an eloquent man, came to Ephesus; and he was mighty in the Scriptures. This man had been instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in spirit, he was speaking and teaching accurately the things concerning Jesus.

Question: What is the potential pitfall of a group of people who experience these two pastors' styles?

Answer: Division and disunity

3 steps in transforming all of your life; including your relationships with God and others

- A. What is man's foolish "wisdom?"
 - "cleverness of speech" –v. 17
 - "wise man, debater" -v. 20
 - "Jews ask for mighty displays of power" -v. 22

1 Corinthians 3:21 - "So then let no one boast in man"

Man's foolish "wisdom" is seeking to be identified with and trusting in what appears to be strong and powerful on earth

 - Destruction in relationships (v. 12)
 - The inability to know God (v. 21)

"the world through its wisdom did not come to know God"

• Ultimately perish (v. 18)

II. Believe the ______ of God's Wise "Foolishness"

A. What is God's wise "foolishness?"

- Was Jesus a good-looking model with muscles and a six-pack? (Is 53:2)
- Was Jesus rich enough to have a big beautiful home? (Matt 8:20)
- Did Jesus have a position of authority? (Phil 2:6-7)
- Did Jesus have celebrity athletic ability? (Is 53:2)
- Did all the crowds heap upon him praise and popularity? (Is 53:3)
- Did Jesus have a spouse? (No)
- Did Jesus have biological children? (No)
- Did Jesus have a high paying job? (No)
- Did Jesus have a Harvard degree? (No)

Question: For what was Jesus known?

Answer: Jesus is known precisely for His lack of being known for anything the world values in life. He is precisely known for his death!

Question: What man on earth has ever been known more for his death than his life? What is the significance of Jesus' crucifixion which has changed the lives of billions?

Answer: Christ's willingness not to seek out or trust in earthly pleasures and treasures so that He could take the destruction, broken relationship with God, and death for your seeking out and trusting in earthly pleasures and treasures.

God's "foolish" wisdom is that He uses the opposite of what the world values in order to save the world. A crucified Messiah instead of a war-mongering king. A servant instead of a boss. Humility instead of pride. Death of His Son instead of the life of His Son. Love instead of self-seeking. The least shall be the greatest. The first shall be last. The humble shall be exalted.
